


Spaying/Neutering

In the U.S. there is a large population of stray dogs and cats entering animal shelters every year. Barely half of these animals are adopted. Tragically, the rest are euthanized. Apart of being very often subject of abuse, cruelty or being euthnized, the stray animals pose a real problem as they can prey on wildlife, cause car accidents, damage the local fauna, frighten children and adults. Spaying and neutering is therefore indispensable and the only effective method for reducing the number of homeless animals.



Main benefits and reasons for spaying/neutering your pet:

- Your female pet will live a longer, healthier life.
- Your spayed female won't go into heat/come into season.
- Your male dog won't want to roam away from home.
- Your male cat won't spray around the house.
- Your neutered male will be much better behaved.
- Neutering provides major health benefits for your male.

Spaying/neutering is highly cost-effective, good for the community and helps to reduce the number of stray animals on the streets.
