



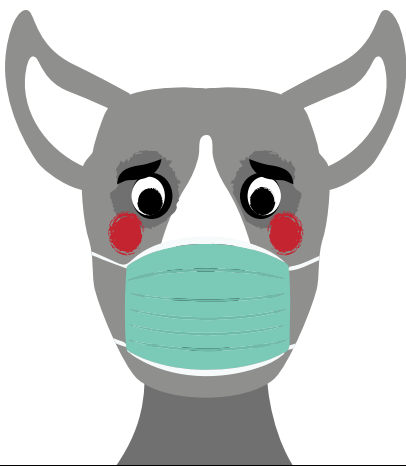
# PICK UP THE POOP

**Carry some plastic bags with you at all times  
(for your dog's poop).**

**Speak out to others that you may see not  
picking up their dog's poop and ask them to  
please help keep the area clean.**



**Ask your local mayor to install "dog poop bag stations" at the local park and public  
areas. These stations provide convenient access to the bags and a waste disposal.**



**Understand the health implications of bacteria from  
exposed dog poop. Dog waste is an environmental pollutant.  
In 1991, it was labeled a non-point source pollutant,  
placing it in the same category as herbicides and  
insecticides; oil, grease and toxic chemicals; and acid  
drainage from abandoned mines.**

A community effort to keep the streets clean and beautiful also shows respect to each other and one's surroundings. Pick up the Poop is a friendly reminder to take responsibility for your dog and help spread the word to others to do the same.
